

Science

In science this term, the pupils will watch a range of lectures, delivered by The Royal Institute, focussing on environmental issues, sustainability and climate change.

The pupils will use a variety of informative sources in order to compile their ideas into a research booklet, acknowledging to their references.

English

In English this term, the initial focus will be on narratives: we will write detailed setting descriptions, imaginative recounts and creative poetry.

Following this, we will write non-chronological reports, linking with our topic of the Americas, offering the pupils the chance to demonstrate their newly acquired factual knowledge of the continents.

Maths

During the topic we will use White Rose Maths to develop our skills in multiplication and division, fractions and decimals and percentages. Within these themes we will develop fluency and problem solving skills.

French

We will continue to learn parts of the body in French and use the vocabulary to describe aliens!

RE

In RE, we will learn how different religions worship and how music, prayer and artefacts are used in worship.

Design and Technology

In design & technology, the pupils will be designing a chair for a specific purpose, based on research and evaluations of chairs throughout history.

Computing

In computing, the pupils will be designing and creating their own playable computer games. They will consider the intended audience and how this affects their decision making (e.g. difficulty level, maturity of content, detail in instructions etc).

PSHCE

In PSHE we will develop our understanding of how to maintain healthy lifestyles (and about the negative effects of drugs, alcohol and tobacco), how to look after our mental health and how to keep safe.

Art and Design

In art, the pupils will design and create their own totem poles. We will use a variety of techniques to add effects (e.g. shadows, reflection, hatching and cross-hatching).

Geography


In geography this term, we will be taking a road trip across the Americas! The pupils will develop their knowledge of climates, terrains, natural resources, environmental issues and grid references.

History

In history, the pupils will, acting as archaeologists, piece together the history of the Native American Iroquois Tribe. They will use a range of source materials (photographs, internet research etc.) to find out about the Native Iroquois tribe. The pupils will explain their findings in a report with headings including food, farming, hunting, clothing, homes, warfare, language and beliefs.

In PE will develop our fitness by following workouts with Joe Wicks and trying to beat our personal bests! We will also vary our exercise by using Cyber Coach to learn new dance routines and develop our knowledge of different dance styles.
